I. Invoice Summary and Project Financial Status

- Invoice Number 1119928 totaling \$284,400,00 is submitted for consideration.
- To-date 32.2% of the total authorized funds have been invoiced.
- The above invoice includes three (3) subconsultant invoices. Invoices from Stormwater Engineering (\$2,437.50), Bockrath & Associates (\$15,971.25) and Applied Weather (\$8,256.00) are attached for your records.

II. Major Issues and Decisions

Data Collection & Analysis

- Soil borings are complete and locations have been surveyed.
 - Laboratory testing of the borings is underway.
 - Laboratory results anticipated by 11/11.
 - o Draft Geotechnical report anticipated by 11/18.
- Finalizing conversion of the existing hydraulic model to unsteady-state and applying refinements to the model including bridge geometry and ineffective flow areas.
 - o Updated area between Blanchard and Lye to a 2-Dimension grid.
 - o Updated model to reflect field survey cross sections.
- Completed development of a refined hydrologic model and calibration review of hydrology.
- Continuing development of new precipitation model.
 - o Our subconsultant, Applied Weather Associates (AWA) is completing analysis of 45-50 storm events.
- Faucett is providing an Economics Impact Analysis report to update the BCR
 - o Draft anticipated the week of 11/7 for review.
- A meeting has been scheduled with ODOT D1 in Lima on 11/14 to discuss bridge design efforts and Environmental Documentation requirements.
- Proposal for aerial survey is under way. Anticipated flight schedule is November.

Concept Refinement

- Completed first internal design charrette on 10/18.
 - o Refine existing alternatives for further analysis on costs/benefits.
- Additional alternatives identified and awaiting model conversion to complete.
 - o Storage on the Blanchard River further evaluated downstream and upstream of Mt. Blanchard.
 - o Bridges at TR139 and TR140 on Blanchard evaluated.
 - o Storage options on Lye Creek under evaluation.
- Further analysis and refinements being made for alternatives including:
 - o Refined modification of proposed channel to convey larger flows.
 - Extension of diversion channel connection to Lye and Blanchard parallel to SR 15.
 - o Removal of low-head dams and riffle structures within City of Findlay.
 - o Stream widening & channel modifications within the City of Findlay
 - HTRW documentation under review
 - o Upstream detention (SR15)
 - o Widening of existing RR bridge opening considered.
 - o Lye Creek cutoff levee.

- Preparing for second internal design charrette on 11/11.
- Cost Curves and Impacts/Benefits table underway
- Began draffing Proof of Concept report.

Permitting

- Pre-Application meeting and site tour with USACE and OEPA completed on 10/6.
- Field activities including Wetland delineation work completed on 11/3. Mussel surveys, processing of results and reporting commenced. No time for these efforts are included within this invoice.
- Coordination underway with Mannik & Smith Group (MSG) and SHPO for Section 106 assistance.
 - o Met with SHPO on 10/24 in Columbus
 - Local meeting for property owner consultation tentatively scheduled for the week of 11/14.
