#### I. Invoice Summary and Project Financial Status

- Invoice Number 1327636 totaling \$5,799.47, for the authorized Supplemental Services related to field investigations for permitting and processing aerial survey (Han. Co. PO No. 01608968), is submitted for consideration. This invoice includes time and expenses applied by Stantec staff.
- A second invoice, Invoice 1327637 totaling \$4,376.25 for the preliminary engineering and Section 106 consultation related to the proposed Hydraulic Improvements (Han. Co. PO No. 01703439), is submitted for consideration. This invoice includes a subconsultant invoice from The Mannik & Smith Group (\$4,376.25).
- A third invoice, Invoice 1327638 totaling \$28,556.77 for tasks associated with the detailed design and agency coordination for the Hydraulic Improvements (Han. Co. PO No. 01705464), is submitted for consideration. This invoice includes time and expenses applied by Stantec staff as well as a subconsultant invoice from Hart Associates, Inc. (\$1,632.34).
- A fourth invoice, Invoice 1327639 totaling \$50,771.71 for tasks associated with the Proof of Concept Update (Han. Co. PO No. 01707430), is submitted for consideration. This invoice includes time and expenses applied by Stantec staff as well as subconsultant invoices from Kucera International Inc. (\$22,530.00) and Storm Water Engineering LLC (\$2,055.00).
- To-date approximately 93.0% of the total authorized funds for the Program have been invoiced.

#### II. Major Issues and Decisions

#### <u>Permitting</u>

- Continued coordination with The Mannik & Smith Group (MSG) for permitting consultation with OHPO related to the Hydraulic Improvements. Comments received to-date have been minor and MSG has provided responses in a timely manner.
- Stantec staff responded to questions and comments provided by USACE for the 404 Permit Application and supplementary documentation. The Public notice for the 404 permit application was issued by USACE and the public comment period will close the week of March 12<sup>th</sup>. To our knowledge, no significant comments in opposition of the proposed plan have been submitted. This is a key project milestone.
- The 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) packet was submitted to the Ohio EPA. Stantec staff responded to several questions and comments, including a revision to the application form itself. We have addressed all items presented to-date and will be submitting a revised application packet the week of March 12<sup>th</sup>. It is anticipated that the 401 WQC will be advertised for Public Notice by March 31<sup>st</sup> and a local public hearing will be established within 45-days thereafter. The Public notice will require publication in a local paper at the cost of project.
- We continue to coordinate the draft Rule 27-13 Application and Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3) for the Hydraulic Improvements that have been submitted to the Ohio EPA. We anticipate completing the final Rule 27-13 Application and related documents by March 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Based upon continued coordination with the City of Findlay for gravity sewers within the
  project area that will need to be upgraded, an Ohio EPA Permit to Install (PTI) will also be
  required for the proposed sanitary sewer replacements at the project site. Stantec staff
  have been working with the City of Findlay to ensure a complete understanding of the
  City's needs and will be submitting the PTI application once the plans have been refined.
  We anticipate completing the detailed design for these improvements and submitting the
  PTI application in late April.

#### Aerial & Ground-Based Survey

- Survey data collection should be complete. Minor efforts to assist in defining the limits of private property impacts may occur as negotiations with private landowners continue.
- Kucera has completed the aerial survey post-processing for creation of 0.5-foot contours within the watershed for refinement of prior concepts. This data allows us to better estimate the impacts of proposed concepts, as well as the potential positive results.

#### Hydraulic Improvements Preliminary & Final Engineering

- Continued tracking and coordination of utility information gathered from the City of Findlay and local utility companies. Discussions and local meetings to discuss potential impacts to the local sewers within Swale Park ("Brandman Area Sewers") are on-going and will continue to be refined through the 95% plan development.
- Continued coordination with MWCD staff regarding proposed impacts to the existing AEP transmission system through Swale Park. Stantec staff have reviewed potential options and impacts. MWCD staff are continuing conversations regarding a possible resolution.
- Stantec staff will be commencing design refinement for the proposed 95% design package of the Hydraulic Improvements Phase 1 efforts and are targeting a deliverable by mid-May, depending on utility coordination issues related to the AEP transmission poles.
- MWCD staff and the design team have been working collaboratively with the Hancock County Landfill to accept the solid waste that will be generated from the excavations within the floodplain benching footprint.
- Continued contact with the Norfolk-Southern RR regarding recommended bridge modifications. Additional follow-up will be on-going for the next several months to obtain an estimate for the cost of the anticipated cooperative agreement with NS.
- The tree clearing contract has been signed and all required submittals have been presented and accepted, including filing the Notice of Intent (NOI) for the Construction SWP3 related to the project. It is our understanding that H&H Land Clearing will be mobilizing into the site the week of March 12<sup>th</sup> and anticipate completion of tree clearing efforts prior to the March 31<sup>st</sup> deadline.

#### Proof of Concept Update

- Jack Faucett Associates (JFA) has continued update and revision of property and structure impact estimates. New data resulting from the improved aerial survey is being developed. Water surface profiles for existing conditions have been provided to JFA for processing and final set up of the HEC-FDA model.
- Updates to the hydrology model are progressing for screening of alternative solutions and "cost curves" for comparison of refined conceptual solutions. Update to the hydraulic model is also continuing to reflect the new hydrology output. Draft refined concepts should be available for review with MWCD staff in April. Numerous iterations and combinations of improvements have been reviewed.

#### Public Information & Outreach

- Continued coordination with HART for the addition of documents to Program webpage (www.HancockCountyFlooding.com) to reflect the addition of program-related documents.
- Continued general monitoring of local media and public relations information.
- A copy of the Q&A responses received from the local presentation on January 24<sup>th</sup> has been posted to the program webpage.
