I. Invoice Summary and Project Financial Status

- Invoice Number 1340853 totaling \$8,484.09, for the authorized Supplemental Services related to field investigations for permitting and processing aerial survey (Han. Co. PO No. 01608968), is submitted for consideration. This invoice includes time and expenses applied by Stantec staff as well as subconsultant invoices from Bockrath & Associates (\$3,500.00) and The Mannik & Smith Group Inc. (\$1,144.12).
- A second invoice, Invoice 1340854 totaling \$1,200.00 for the preliminary engineering and Section 106 consultation related to the proposed Hydraulic Improvements (Han. Co. PO No. 01703439), is submitted for consideration. This invoice includes a subconsultant invoice from Bockrath & Associates (\$1,200.00).
- A third invoice, Invoice 1340855 totaling \$27,284.27 for tasks associated with the detailed design and agency coordination for the Hydraulic Improvements (Han. Co. PO No. 01705464), is submitted for consideration. This invoice includes time and expenses applied by Stantec staff as well as a subconsultant invoice from Hart Associates, Inc. (\$793.73).
- A fourth invoice, Invoice 1340856 totaling \$35,460.54 for tasks associated with the Proof of Concept Update (Han. Co. PO No. 01707430), is submitted for consideration. This invoice includes time and expenses applied by Stantec staff as well as subconsultant invoices from Applied Weather Associates (\$9,800.00), Bockrath & Associates (\$5,000.00), and Jack Faucett Associates, Inc. (\$5,020.00).
- To-date approximately 95.5% of the total authorized funds for the Program have been invoiced.

II. Major Issues and Decisions

Permitting

- Continued coordination with The Mannik & Smith Group (MSG) for permitting consultation
 with OHPO related to the Hydraulic Improvements. Comments received to-date have
 been minor and MSG has provided responses in a timely manner. OHPO has not provided
 comments to USACE for Section 106 Consultation.
- The 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) application packet has been submitted to the Ohio EPA and we have coordinated several specific elements with the Agency, including the revised application fees. Based upon conversations with OEPA staff, we anticipate that the 401 WQC Public Notice will be provided the week of April 9th for advertisement. The Public notice will require publication in a local paper at the cost of project. Based upon the delay in completing the 401 Public Notice, the local public hearing cannot occur until mid-May at the earliest.
- The public notice period for the USACE 404 Permit is closed. This is a key project milestone.
- We have continued to coordinate the draft Rule 27-13 Application for the Brandman Site. Review comments and responses have been coordinated with the OEPA as we advance toward a final application packet. The final packet should be presented to the OEPA by April 30th.
- The draft Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWP3) for the Hydraulic Improvements has been accepted by the OEPA and will be included within the final design package and formal Rule 13 submission.
- An Ohio EPA Permit to Install (PTI) will also be required for the proposed sanitary sewer replacements at the project site. Stantec staff have been working with the City of Findlay to ensure a complete understanding of the City's needs and will be submitting the PTI application once the plans have been refined. We anticipate completing the detailed design for these improvements and submitting the draft PTI application form and permit fee estimate to the District in late April.

Aerial & Ground-Based Survey

• Survey is complete for the current tasks.

Hydraulic Improvements Preliminary & Final Engineering

- Continued coordination with MWCD staff regarding proposed impacts to the existing AEP transmission system through Swale Park. Stantec staff have reviewed potential options and impacts. MWCD staff are continuing conversations regarding a possible resolution.
- Stantec staff continued design refinement for the proposed 95% design package of the Hydraulic Improvements Phase 1 efforts and are targeting a deliverable by mid-May.
- Design elements impacted by the permitting review comments received thus far are being modified to reflect the review agency requirements.
- Continued contact with the Norfolk-Southern RR (NS) regarding recommended bridge modifications. Additional follow-up will be on-going for the next several months to obtain an estimate for the cost of the anticipated cooperative agreement with NS.
- The tree clearing contract is substantially complete. We have been working with the contractor to finalize punch list items for the nominal restoration required to stabilize the disturbed areas and minimize opportunity for erosion. A pay request for the efforts to-date is in development and will be provided to the District once finalized.

Proof of Concept Update

- Jack Faucett Associates (JFA) has continued update and revision of property and structure impact estimates. New data resulting from the improved aerial survey have been provided and they are editing the structure inventory to reflect properties that have been acquired. Water surface profiles for existing and future conditions have been provided to JFA for processing and final set up of the HEC-FDA model.
- Updates to the hydrology model are progressing for screening of alternative solutions and "cost curves" for comparison of refined conceptual solutions. Draft refined concepts should be available for review with MWCD staff in April. Numerous iterations and combinations of improvements have been reviewed.
- MSG and Stantec staff have assembled information related to permitting expectations related to potential project sites.
- Geotechnical report has been finalized. Began preparing an outline of proposed summary report document.

<u>Public Information & Outreach</u>

- Continued coordination with HART for the addition of documents to Program webpage (www.HancockCountyFlooding.com) to reflect the addition of program-related documents.
- Continued general monitoring of local media and public relations information.
- As noted under the Permitting summary above, as local public hearing for the 401 WQC will occur yet this Spring.
